ALUMNI AWARDS PROGRAM

For more than 90 years UBC has produced graduates who have impressed the world with their accomplishments. These achievers brave uncertainty and challenge the tried-and-true to discover new ways of seeing, thinking and being.

Every year the UBC Alumni Association recognizes some of these men and women with special awards presented at the Alumni Achievement Awards celebration. We count on members of our community to notice these remarkable achievers, and to tell us about them by nominating them for the awards listed here. Our Awards committee then reviews the nominations and selects this year's recipients.

With more than 250,000 grads, UBC has produced accomplished members of every endeavour, and the selection process is never easy. The information you provide for this nomination should be concise and complete, giving the members of our awards committee everything they need to make the right decision.

HOW TO NOMINATE

Please refer to the criteria listed on the following page and explain in a letter (*maximum 2 pages*) why this candidate should be chosen to receive a specific award. Include aspects of the candidate's life and career that qualify him/her for the award. Enclose a CV (*maximum 4 pages*) including any of the following information that is relevant to this candidate's nomination:

- Positions held, both professional and voluntary
- National or international recognition
- Previous recognition by UBC or the UBC Alumni Association
- Summary of publications
- Membership in professional or honorary societies
- For the Alumni Milestones Award, please explain in a letter (*maximum 2 pages*) why this group should be recognized. A CV is not required.

Nominations are considered for two years. The nominator is responsible for updating supporting information as needed. Nominees are drawn from all areas of endeavor and reflect the quality of the University of British Columbia. An award in each category may not be granted every year.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award recognizes an extraordinary individual who through a lifetime of outstanding service and contribution to the community has demonstrated the true spirit of the Association's mission and set an example for all who follow. The recipient must have a UBC degree or be an honorary alumnus.

ALUMNI AWARD OF DISTINCTION

The Alumni Award of Distinction recognizes the outstanding achievements of a UBC alumnus (undergraduate or graduate) whose endeavours in professional research, civic duty, business, athletics, the arts, the community or other areas have made a significant contribution to the community and UBC.

HONORARY ALUMNUS AWARD

The Honorary Alumnus Award recognizes significant contributions made by a non-UBC alumnus to the Alumni Association and/or UBC.

OUTSTANDING YOUNG ALUMNUS AWARD

This award is presented to a UBC alumnus under 35 (before December 31 of the year in which the award is made) whose endeavours in professional research, civic duty, business, athletics, the arts, the community or other areas worthy of recognition, bring honour to UBC.

BLYTHE EAGLES VOLUNTEER LEADERSHIP AWARD

This award honours an alumnus who has shown extraordinary leadership in support of UBC's more than 250,000 alumni. Current members of the Association's board are not eligible for nomination.

OUTSTANDING FUTURE ALUMNUS AWARD

This award recognizes a UBC student who has demonstrated ambassador-like qualities on behalf of UBC and who has excelled in one or a number of the following: leadership, academic success, community service, university service, athletic or artistic achievement, faculty recognition or other areas worthy of recognition. The candidate's contributions can be made in the year of nomination or over several years. A letter of reference from a university faculty or department is required.

GLOBAL CITIZENSHIP AWARD

This award recognizes a UBC graduate who has made a significant contribution to the betterment of the global community through one or more of the following: research initiatives, teaching, social, cultural or artistic innovation, healthcare, economic development, human rights and environmental protection.

OUTSTANDING FACULTY COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

This award recognizes a member of UBC's faculty, either active or emeriti, who has rendered outstanding community service in areas other than teaching and research. The recipient need not be a UBC alumnus.

ALUMNI MILESTONE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award recognizes the accomplishments of a group of alumni whose collective efforts have created an institutional milestone and made a unique contribution to the life and goals of the university.

NOTE: One award per category will be awarded. Posthumous awards will not normally be granted.

OUR MISSION

Alumni Affairs engages alumni, and students as future alumni, in the life of the university in its broadest sense. Through communications, connecting alumni to the institution and one another, and celebrating milestones, we enrich the lives of alumni and position them to be supporters of and advocates for UBC.
